General Teacher Job Description

- Promote and nurture the education of students by planning and tailoring courses of study according to Smith Preparatory Academy's curriculum guidelines; monitoring, assisting with, and correcting academic efforts; providing a safe environment conducive to learning; keeping parents informed.

- 4. Maintain order in the classroom with discretion and wisdom, referring students to administration as needed.
- 5. Maintain safe, secure, and healthy educational environments by establishing, following, and enforcing standards and procedures, complying with legal regulations.
- 6. Keep the parents informed by maintaining records of academic performance; reporting on all elements of student development at parent-teacher conferences, both regularly scheduled and as-needed.
